

#### **Purpose of Meeting**




- Initiate first step in response to stakeholders' requests for a Northside neighborhoodfocused Livability Plan

# **Corpus Christi Livability Summit Results**




- 70+ attendees businesses, residents, government, students






# **Downtown Development Plan Study Area**


